WHEREAS, the consumer has applied to the MePDCL for supply of electricity to its premises and the MePDCL has agreed to give the supply under the terms and conditions hereinafter appearing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the agreement witnesses -

- 1. That the supply shall be given to the premises located at Naural with the consumer as owner/ occupier of;
- 2. That the supply shall be for the purpose of 220 VDLT

 The load whereof shall not exceed 2700 watter
- 3. That the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 and the Regulations, Code Orders in cluding Tariff Orders, as may be made from time to time by the Meghalaya State Electricity Regulatory Commission shall apply and bind the consumer and the distribution utility alike.
- 4. That the consumer shall regularly and timely pay to the MePDCL all charges as may be due for the supply of electricity.
- 5. That the agreement shall be a period of two years and may be renewed for a further period :

Provided that supply shall not be terminated by mere efflux of time if the consumer is willing that the agreement is renewed.

That the Agreement shall be terminated if the consumer on its part desires it so and gives to the MePDCL a prior notice of not less than one month or, on the part of the MePDCL, if the consumer has violated any of the terms and conditions of the agreement
